Autumn Aerial Affair is for Silks & Lyra experienced students, who have a minimum intermediate skill level on silks or lyra and a HIGH desire to make astonishing progress through hard work, education and dedication!

Note

Participants must meet strength and skill requirements for safety, and be comfortable and competent exploring basic choreography on both Silks and lyra.

If you predominantly work on only silks or lyra (not both) you will be able to work on your preferred apparatus for the majority of the program. But please be prepared to spend a little time (using basic skills only!) on the other!

What is the minimum strength/skill level required to participate?

- You have current and/or previous experience with aerials at an intermediate level or above
- You can aerial invert with correct form on both silks and lyra. (No swinging, beating or pushing off the post).
- You can knee climb with correct technique on silks and can pike up to knee hang on top bar, cleanly and confidently on lyra.
- You can confidently perform single knee hangs on lyra.
- Strength requirement = Minimum 3, full extension, correct form chin ups
- Minimum 3, clean aerial inverts, without wrapping on/touching ground.
 (Aerial Artistry students successfully completed minimum one term level L3 silks &/or lyra)

These guide lines are set out for safety reasons, as this program is in no way aimed at beginners to aerial arts.

This will be a rigorous two days of training, and by signing up you are acknowledging that you have the endurance, strength and stamina to take on the intensive training planned. Please note that the Aerial Artistry® instructors do reserve the right to ask you to sit out of the workshops, with no refund applicable, if you sign up to the program but are unable to safely execute the basic strength & skill requirements as listed above.

WHAT KIND OF TRAINING WILL WE BE DOING?

Autumn Aerial Affair is predominantly a performance based program.

During these two days you will be treated as performers, and be trained accordingly! Our aim is to assist you in becoming the best aerialist you can be, by utilising training techniques that the Aerial Artistry professional troupe have used and continue to use, throughout their career's.

(This program is not about learning a tonne of new skills as such, so please do not sign up if that is all you are after!)

During the program we will cover:

- Learning new aerial choreography
- · Performance based flexibility & strength work
- Taking chorey from "Simple" to "Stunning"
- Basic dance/acro choreography with a range of music styles
- How to move from floor to apparatus
- Chorey creation on unusual apparatus
- · Nutrition for aerialists... and more!
